Classical Ballet Centre COVID-19 Protocol

In order to stay safe and socially distance, CBC is instituting the following protocols for in studio classes. These protocols may change as advised by our government and to follow recommended best practices. All classes will be available via Zoom as well as in person. Individuals who enter the studio, or whose family members enter the studio, waive all claims of liability if they contract COVID as a result of their interaction at CBC.

- If a child or any family member tests positive for COVID 19 we ask they refrain from coming to the studio. They are welcome to stream via Zoom.
- If your child feels ill, Please DO NOT BRING THEM TO CLASS. If there are sick family members in the home, we ask that a student only join us if the family member has had a negative test for COVID 19.
- After having visited the studio if your child becomes ill or if any of your family members test positive for COVID please notify Ms. Mel IMMEDIATELY so she can contact any other families that may have been in contact with your child and they can isolate.

Arriving at the CBC

Please wait in the car until 5 minutes before class time. Students should approach the door one at a time when they see Ms. Mel outside the studio. Students should wear masks when approaching and entering the studio. Before entering the studio, each student will have their temperature taken. If they show signs of fever they will be sent back to their parent. Students must arrive fully dressed for class, only needing to change to ballet shoes. A small bag for pointe shoes is allowed. Students in Level 2 and up may bring a water bottle.

Students must wear a mask for the entire lesson. Please contact Ms. Mel if student has a health condition that prevents the use of masks.

Parents

Only students will be allowed to enter the studio. Pick up and drop off will be outside of the building. Parents of Students in Level 2 and up should wait in their vehicle. Parents should not gather at the front door, please wait on the sidewalk in front of the parking lot and wear a mask. Always maintain 6-feet of distance between parents. DO NOT BE LATE picking up your child.

Parents in the Primary Class – If you are new to CBC, your child may feel more comfortable having you in the lobby at least for the first classes. In this case, you may wait in the lobby and wear a mask. Other parents please wait outside where I can see you. I will look for you in case your child needs to use the restroom or if there are other issues.

Washing Hands

Children in Primary and Level 1 will be provided hand sanitizer as they enter the building. All other students must wash their hands before entering the studio. Please make sure younger students have used the facilities before they arrive at CBC.

Dressing rooms and Studio Sanitation

Barres will be sanitized and back door to the studio will be opened between classes. A full cleaning, including floors, bathrooms and dressing rooms will be done daily.

Safety First

CBC's intention by implementing these protocols is to minimize risk of virus transfer. Our intention is to follow Government regulations, which may include shutting down. If there is an order to shut down or shutting down is in the best interest of the students, we intend to continue to offer classes via Zoom.
